1. What is this event?

Hillel's 5th annual charity golf tournament, now featuring celebrity athletes, will be held on **Monday, July 17, 2023**, at Valley Country Club in Centennial, CO. Our day kicks off at 11:00 am with registration, time to hit balls and a buffet luncheon, followed by a 1:00 pm sharp shotgun-start and a post-golf award-'n-nosh reception.

2. What is Hillel of Colorado?

We are an independent, 75-year-old nonprofit organization that works to inspire every Colorado Jewish college student to make an enduring commitment to Jewish life, learning, and Israel. Hillel builds a Jewish community whose values enrich the lives of students during their college years and beyond. We are the Jewish *home-away-from-home* for 2,000+ Jewish students and their allies at the University of Denver and at Colorado State University in Ft. Collins – with outreach to a dozen other colleges in metro-Denver and northern Colorado.

3. Why is Hillel holding a golf tournament?

Hillel of Colorado is one of 500 proud North American affiliates of Hillel International, but 100% of our funding comes from local sponsors, donors, and alumni. This tournament helps to support our programs and Hillel's critical mission on campus.

4. Is this new?

This is our fifth consecutive annual summer charity golf tournament – the first featuring celebrity athletes. Enjoy a relaxing scramble format on a great private course with food, prizes, and programs. Most importantly, come together to assure that Hillel's programming remains strong and to support tomorrow's Jewish community leaders.

5. What does it cost?
