1. What is Hillel Golf?

Hillel's 7th annual charity golf tournament will be held on **Monday, July 14, 2025**, at Inverness Golf Club in Englewood, Colorado. Our day kicks off at 11:00 am with registration, time to hit balls and a breakfast buffet, followed by a 1:00 pm sharp shotgun-start and a post-golf award dinner.

2. What is Hillel of Colorado?

Our statewide Hillel was incorporated in 2002 as an independent nonprofit organization; our individual campus Hillels date from the 1950's. Our work *inspires every Colorado Jewish college student to make an enduring commitment to Jewish life, learning, and Israel*. Hillel builds a Jewish community whose values enrich the lives of students during their college years and beyond. We are the Jewish *home-away-from-home* for 2,000+ Jewish students and their allies, with Houses at the University of Denver, Auraria Campus in downtown Denver, and at Colorado State University in Ft. Collins – with outreach and programming to a half-dozen other Front Range colleges.

3. Why is Hillel holding a golf tournament?

Hillel of Colorado is one of 500+ proud North American affiliates of Hillel International. 100% of our funding comes from local sponsors, donors, and alumni. This tournament helps to support our programs and Hillel's critical mission on campus.

This is our seventh consecutive annual summer charity golf tournament. Funding Jewish campus life has never been more important.
